

PARKING CONTROL OFFICER

(Competitive Class)

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS

This is routine police work in the checking of parking violations, issuing of citations for overtime or illegal parking and assisting at school crossings. Work involves patrolling an assigned area in accordance with prescribed departmental rules and regulations. Work is performed under the general supervision of a superior officer.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

(NOTE: These examples below indicate only the general type of work performed in these positions and are **NOT** intended to restrict duties to those listed.)

Checks for parking violations in an assigned area.

Issues citations for overtime or illegal parking.

Assists in helping children cross the street at school crossings.

Answers questions for and directs the public.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Must be not less than twenty-one years of age on the closing date of application for examination.

After offer of employment, but before beginning work in this class, must pass a medical examination prepared and administered by the Appointing Authority, designed to demonstrate good health and physical fitness sufficient to perform the essential duties of the position, with or without accommodation.

Must be a high school graduate or possess an equivalent certificate as certified by an accredited state institution of education.
